Get the Facts Daguerreotype was the first successful photographic process. This process took 10 to 20 minutes to properly expose to available light. Therefore, people were required to sit still for that period of time to have their picture taken. The word "photography" comes from the Greek words for light and writing.		Concurrent enrollment course offerings vary by school and district. Foundation courses taken beyond the required credits can be used as elective credit.
